| Galatians 1 | Paul opens his letter with his identity as an apostle of Christ. He then shares how sad he is that the Galatians have turned from the gospel. He then goes into his own personal experience at his conversion. |
| Galatians 2 | He then talks about his trip to Jerusalem and how he had to rebuke Peter. |
| Galatians 3 | He talks about justification by faith using Abraham, the law, works by the Son God, and works of the Spirit as his argument. |
| Galatians 4 | Paul talks about legalism and uses an example of a Roman father and his son and then he uses Hagar and Sarah, as an allegory to the law of Moses and the grace of God |
| Galatians 5 | Paul talks about justification by faith and how it brings about both freedom and Fruit of the Spirit. |
| Galatians 6 | Paul ends his letter with some final instructions on how to live and how they are only to boast in the cross of Christ. |
