3 Key Points of Hebrews

- Jesus is our High Priest
- The superiority of Christ in both His personage and in His ministering work
- Jesus Christ is better than anything religious legalism has to offer

Chapter	Summarization
Hebrews 1	God chose his Son to minister and he is superior to the angels.
Hebrews 2	a warning is given to not drift or disobey God's message of truth and discusses the work of Christ.
Hebrews 3	Jesus is measured against and is stated to be greater than Moses. We are warned that it is a terrible to have a sin of unbelief.
Hebrews 4	God has kept his promise to all people, the word that he has given us is living and active and Jesus is our great High Priest.
Hebrews 5	Jesus is the great High Priest and He is compared and contrasted to Aaron the high priest.
Hebrews 6	Spiritually we are told to not go backwards, but to go forward. We are reminded that God promised to bless Abraham, which he did, and God promised to bless us.
Hebrews 7	Jesus is compare to Melchizedek and a gives several characteristics that describes Jesus.
Hebrews 8	The New Covenant is better than the Old Covenant as Jesus is a better minister and that he, the Lamb of God, offers up himself.

Hebrews 9 The earthly and heavenly sanctuaries are discussed and the heavenly sanctuary is superior to the earthly one however, both had to be cleansed by a blood sacrifice.

Hebrews 10 The earthly sacrifices are compared to the sacrifice of the lamb of God and We are to live out our lives for him helping others and trusting in God.

Hebrews 11 Here faith is discussed and several heroes of the faith are given as examples and their reward is explained.

Hebrews 12 A godly life is compared to a race, God's discipline is explained and we are warned against the sin of unbelief.

Hebrews 13 Love, leadership, legalism and Jesus as the great shepherd are explained.
