5 Key Points of Mark

- Jesus is Baptized and confirmed by God
- Jesus teaches, performs miracles and heals
- Jesus prepares for death
- Jesus dies on the cross
- Jesus is resurrected and commands his disciples to teach

Chapter	Summarization
Mark 1	John baptizes Jesus. In the wilderness Jesus is tempted by Satan. Jesus calls his first disciples, begins his teaching and heals many.
Mark 2	Jesus' is challenged by the Pharisees for doing what the Pharisees think he should not do and for not doing what the Pharisees think he should do.
Mark 3	The Pharisees are angry that Jesus heals a man on the Sabbath. Large groups of people follow Jesus as he heals the sick and demon-possessed individuals. Jesus picks his twelve disciples and teaches the.
Mark 4	Jesus is lead by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the Devil. After this Jesus returns to start his ministry and gather followers.
Mark 5	Jesus heals a possessed man and sends the evil spirits into a bunch of pigs. A woman touches Jesus' robe and is healed because of her faith. Jesus a dead girl back to life. ²
Mark 6	The town where Jesus grew up reject him. The disciples are sent out to preach and heal. John the Baptist was beheaded by Herod. Jesus feeds 5,000 people and walks on water.

Mark 7	Jesus teaches people and heals a woman's demon-possessed daughter. He also heals a deaf-dumb man.
Mark 8	Jesus feeds 4,000. Jesus rejects the Pharisees demand that he perform a miraculous sign. He heals a blind man then foretells of his own death. Jesus asks who people say he is and Peter says that Jesus is the Messiah.
Mark 9	Jesus is transfiguring on the mountaintop with Moses and Elijah. Jesus heals a demon-possessed boy. He foretells his death and resurrection.
Mark 10	Jesus teaches about childlike faith, divorce and worldly and heavenly riches. He foretells his death. Jesus heals a blind man.
Mark 11	On a donkey Jesus enters triumphantly into Jerusalem. He then drives the corrupt merchants out of the Temple. He confronts the Pharisees
Mark 12	Jesus tells the parable of vineyard tenants and talks about taxes and the resurrection. Jesus teaches the first and second commandments. He praises a poor widow for her offering.
Mark 13	Jesus teaches about the events that will take place during the Great Tribulation.
Mark 14	A woman pours expensive perfume over Jesus' head. Then Jesus celebrates Passover with the disciples, goes to Gethsemane, prays in the garden, arrested and abandoned by his disciples.
Mark 15	Jesus is put on trial before Pilate, put to death by crucifixion and buried for our sins.
Mark 16	The resurrection of Jesus is announced. Jesus appears before his disciples and commands them to preach the Good News and is taken up into heaven.
