5 Key Points of Revelation

- The revelation of Jesus Christ
- Satan wants to be God
- A Great Tribulation is coming
- All will be judged
- Believers will live in Heaven with God

Chapter	Summarization
Revelation 1	John receives a vision from God that is to be sent to the seven churches in Asia. What and who Jesus Christ is, is revealed. The Lampstands and stars are discussed.
Revelation 2	Christ condemns Ephesus for losing their first love, but those who repent will receive fruit from the tree of life in paradise. Smyrna is commended for how they live despite being poor and being slandered by others. Christ commends them for living in a difficult place, but scorns them for putting up with Nicolaitans. Christ commends Thyatira for their works, love, faith, and patience, but scorns them allowing a false prophetess named Jezebel to teach.
Revelation 3	Sardis is commended for not soiled their garments with sin, but condemned for being spiritually dead. Philadelphia is commended for keeping Gods word and not denying Him and are not scorned for anything. Laodicea is not commended for anything and is scorned for boasting in their riches and being luke warm.
Revelation 4	In Heaven john see a throne, twenty-four elders, Seven spirits of God, and four living creatures. He also hears a song of praise.

Revelation 5 John sees a seven-sealed scroll as an angel asks if anyone is able to break the seals and open the scroll. Jesus Christ steps forward to do so and a song of praise is given to God for his wonderful work of redemption.

Revelation 6 Christ breaks the first six seals:
1. A white horse whose rider goes out to conquer with a bow in his hand and a crown on his head. 2. A red horse whose rider is given power to take peace from the earth. 3. A black horse whose rider is holding a pair of scales, indicating a great famine. 4. A pale green horse whose rider is death. 5. The martyrs ask when will Christ avenge them. 6. The sun turns black, and the moon turns blood red, the stars fall, the sky rolls up like a scroll and every mountain and island is removed from its place.

Revelation 7 The sealing of God's 144,000 witnesses takes place. A song about the those who are being saved during the Great Tribulation is heard.

Revelation 8 The seventh seal is opened which are the seven trumpets.
1. One-third of the trees and grass are burned by hail and fire mixed with blood. 2. One-third of sea life and ships are destroyed. 3. One-third of the fresh water is poisoned by something called bitterness 4. One third of the sun, moon, and stars are darkened.

Revelation 9 5. Demon locust are set loose 6. Four demons kill one-third of all the people left. Still many refuse to repent.

Revelation 10 John is forbidden to write what he hears the seven thunders say. He is told to eat a scroll that is sweet in his mouth, but makes his stomach sour.

Revelation 11 John sees two witnesses of God who serve for 3 ½ years before being killed by the Antichrist. God brings them back to life and they are brought into heaven. The seventh trumpet is blown. Much praise for His reign, power and judgment is given to God through song

Revelation 12 Satan hates the woman and her offspring and persecutes the woman. A great battle is described taking place in heaven with Satan eventually being kicked out.

Revelation 13 The Beast out of the Sea is explained to be the Antichrist. He has a fatal wound to the head and he will be worshiped. The Beast out of the Earth is explained to be the false prophet. He has great power and will require that everyone has the mark of

Revelation 14 144,000 sing a song of praise to God. An angel says to give glory to him when he will sit as judge. Worship him.” Another angel says that Babylon has fallen. The Final angel warns people to not “receive the mark of the Antichrist” as it will condemn themselves. Jesus comes to reap and harvest the earth.

Revelation 15 The seven angels prepare to pour more judgments on the earth and those who have been victorious over the beast of the sea sing a song of praise.

Revelation 16 The seven Judgments:
1. Horrible malignant sores break out on those who have received the mark of the beast. 2. The waters become as blood, killing all life in them. 3. fresh water sources also become as blood. 4. The sun now scorches all people with its fire. 5. His entire kingdom is plunged into darkness. 6. Euphrates dries up and the kings of the east march westward across the Euphrates. 7. A great earthquake occurs, Babylon is split into three parts, all the great cities fall, islands vanish, and mountains are flattened, HUGE hailstones fall from the sky.

Revelation 17 A prostitute woman rides a beast with seven heads and ten horns. She represents a corrupt religious system and the beast represents various kings.

Revelation 18 The city of Babylon is leveled by God and people cry “How terrible, how terrible for Babylon, that great city!”

Revelation 19 A song of praise is given to Christ and he returns to earth and destroys his enemies. The Antichrist and false prophet are thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 20 For one thousand years Christ rules on earth. After 1,000 years, Satan is let loose for a time and is finally defeated. He is then thrown into hell. The Great White Throne Judgment occurs.

Revelation 21 John has a vision of the New Jerusalem describing that it shines like a precious jewel and pure gold and then he gives the size and dimensions. In Heaven there is no Temple no sun and no evil.

Revelation 22 In the city is a river of life and a tree of life. John describes Christ and falls down to worship an angel who tells him to only worship the Creator. He is told not to seal up the writings or add to them.
